1. The following tables, giving the prices of miscellaneous supplies, revised December 31, 1921, are published for the information and guidance of all concerned, to take effect upon receipt.

2. Articles of miscellaneous supplies not listed herein, but regularly caried in stock, will be sold or charged at invoice prices.

3. The articles herein enumerated, when furnished to the National Guard not in the Federal Service, and to other executive departments of the Government, shall have added to the prices herein given 4 per cent to cover the cost of packing or crating.

4. Miscellaneous supplies purchased in Manila for service in the Philippine Islands will be charged at invoice or cost price.


