4. Miscellaneous supplies purchased in Manila for service in the Philippine Islands will be charged at invoice or cost price.

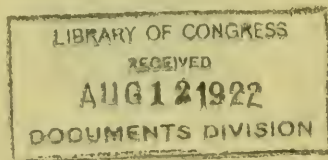
