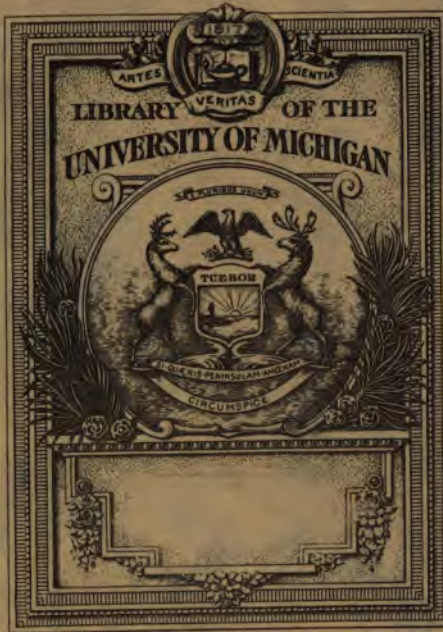

## **RULES FOR THE CIRCULATION OF BOOKS.**

Briefly stated, the rules for the drawing of books by the children are as follows:

A book may be kept two weeks and the time may be renewed once, except in cases where the books are in bad condition after two weeks' use, or are of the nature of reference books, or are new books which are in constant demand; notice is given at the time of drawing of the latter. If kept over two weeks without renewal, a fine of ten cents a week, two cents for each school day, is charged. If not returned at the end of three weeks from date of drawing a printed notice is sent through the mail, and if this is not heeded within a week, a messenger is sent for the book, and ten cents extra is added to the fine. The young people are urged to keep all books clean and to remember that they must not mark them in any way or turn down the leaves. A neat book-mark bearing a story from a book to its readers (the "Maxson book-mark") is given to each one who wishes it.

It is the unwritten law that only one story book a week shall be drawn by any pupil below the high school, unless parents send written requests to the librarian for their children to have books oftener.

The library is open every school day from 8 a. m. to 5 p. m.



## PREFACE.

The library is classified by the system called the Dewey Decimal Classification, which consists of ten classes represented by the common Arabic numerals:

| 2. Religion      | 7. Fine Arts        |
| 3. Sociology     | 8. Literature       |

Each of these classes is divided into nine divisions, and each division into nine sections; thus 598 means Class 5 (Natural Science), Division 9 (Zoölogy), Section 8 (Birds), and all books on birds (separate from other animals) are numbered 598. In making up a list of books desired, all figures and letters which are at the right hand end of the entries must be written; for example, if one should wish one of the books of folk stories by Joel Chandler Harris, the number must be written out thus: 398.2H24-3; if only H24-3 is put on the list, the story about his life when a boy, "On the plantation," will be sent, and altho it is a very interesting book, and many will want to read it, it is not a folk story nor a fairy story. There is a class number for stories, but it is left off to save work in charging the books; therefore, when there is *not any class* number on a list it is understood by the librarians that all the numbers are for stories, and if the numbers have not been copied correctly they will not be able to find any book to send.

This list includes all the books in the library which are in language within the understanding of the *average* child in grades below the high school, third grade to eighth grade in-

clusive. Purposely, no attempt has been made to signify which are especially for any particular grade or age; it is best for the children to make their own selections, and a number of books will be shown them whenever they desire, from which they may choose. Following the course with the older readers, the "great readers" among the younger folk have been allowed two books at a time, one story book and one other book *not* a story—the life of some famous person or a book of travel or history. In this way the child does not lose his sweet in the form of the story and gains also more nutritious diet from the other books.

It is hoped that the plan of connecting the biography with the subject or country and listing it just after, in each instance, instead of all together in a separate class, will commend itself to the younger readers and to others. Parents and teachers have a great opportunity in their constant association with the little folks that the librarian cannot have to interest and incite them to worthy effort in the line of reading, and a mutual enjoyment of what is best in literature creates a bond that is tender and lasting and more and more precious in its "memory pictures" to these little folks as they advance in years and experience.
