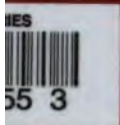


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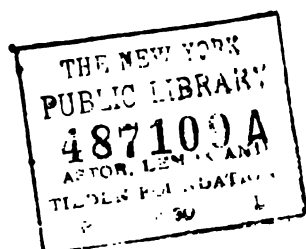

CUM quatuor abhinc annis mihi demandata esset Provincia BIBLIOTHECÆ CHETHAMENSIS apud MANCU- NIENSES custodiendæ, placuit sanè Curatoribus nobilissimis spectatissimisque, ut Libris, qui propter plurimam per nuperos annos accessionem in Catalogis non describerentur, descriptis, et qui ex legentium incuriâ longè distraherentur, ad forulos suos redactis, statim ad novum Librorum Catalogum conficiendum me accingerem, quem ut publici esset juris, typis evulgari volebant. Manus victas temerè, confiteor, dedi, eorum voluntatis, quàm virium mearum, observantior, qui in re bibliographica planè hospes et rudis essem. Quoniam verò non meum erat, quod Fundator publicæ utilitati dicavit, id publico invidere, posthabita modestiâ importunâ, quam mallem opportunam vocare, mecum decrevi tam utili instituto pro virili incumbere. Huic tamen decreto ne tam instanter satisfacerem quàm volui, obstabat illa prior, nec facilis cura. Notandi enim erant in Catalogis libri quamplurimi, qui hinc illinc in Bibliothecâ latitantes cum oculos, tum manus effugiebant, ut primò perfectiores evaderent; deindè in forulos suos colligendi, quò faciliùs, quanta esset in unâquâque facultate supellex, innotesceret. Hoc tamen nè fieret, sæpiùs propter numerum formamque suam prohibuit angustia loci; qui tam iniquè huic præ illi facultati contigit, ut libri complures in propriis locis frustra quærerentur, et videre esset Medicum suâ sede destitutum Jurisperiti lateri adhærere, Poetas cum Mathematicis, Mathematicos cum Historicis societatem inire, sacra denique cum profanis commisceri; ut non mente solùm notandus, sed manu movendus esset unusquisque errabundus liber.

Necesse erat igitur, ut, veteribus scriniis in altitudinem erectis, adderentur utrinque foruli, qui, prout occasio postularet, libros exciperent, et vagantibus sedem inter concives darent. Hi foruli plerumque minoris formæ sunt, ut ubi minusculi libri, quod plurimis accidit, magnam eorum partem implebant, spatiumque invadebant grandioribus destinatum, ibi auxilium præsentius adesset.

Facta est, quantùm mihi tunc temporis licebat, instituta distributio; et tum denique ut alteræ curæ animum manumque adhiberem, meipsum strenuè adhortabar. Hæc igitur illam excepit; quàm bonis auspiciis lectoris est judicare, qui inusitati operis errores benevolè condonabit. Res equidem erat, ut experientia docebat, non unius momenti, nec unius anni, si fidem Cl. Hyde habeamus, qui se Bibliothecæ Bodleianæ Catalogo, illique tantùm alphabetico, annos novendecim insumpisse fatetur. Nam ut Bibliothecæ Catalogus describeretur non solùm Nomina autorum ordine alphabetico, sed etiam secundùm varia sua argumenta in varias classes voluminumque formas minutatim disponens, res ipsa postulabat, ut eadem operâ, et quæ suppeditamus, et quibus indigemus, studioso lectori facilè appareat.
