## PREFACE

The development in staphylococci of resistance to antibiotics has resulted in the acquisition of lethal properties not confined to single clinical cases, but occasionally causing hospital epidemics, notably in nurseries, maternity wards and surgical wards. Hospital outbreaks are sometimes so general that they necessitate closing the entire hospital. Nor is this condition confined to the hospital; it is also found in the home, the school and in the community.

This bibliography consists of references to English, French and German literature on the clinical and epidemiological aspects of staphylococcal infection. Bacteriological studies were not considered per se, but they appear in many articles as an adjunct to the main thesis.

The references were selected from the public catalog of the National Library of Medicine, Quarterly Cumulative Index Medicus, Current List of Medical Literature and from sections, 4, 6, 7, 9, and 17 of Excerpta Medica: Medical Microbiology and Serology, Internal Medicine, Pediatrics, Surgery, and Public Health, Social Medicine and Hygiene; all available issues of these publications for the period 1952 to May 1958 were searched. The most recent numbers of selected periodicals, not yet indexed, were examined for pertinent articles.
