

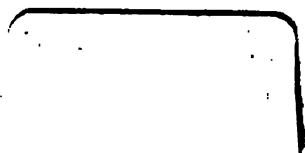

## PREFATORY.

This Bulletin contains a list of all additions to the department of local history and genealogy in the Grosvenor Library since the publication of the catalogue issued March 1st, 1900. These additions number 452 volumes, and embrace many important books or series such as the publications of the Harleian Society, the Holland Society's Year-Book, the series of vital records of Massachusetts towns published as the Eddy Town Record Fund Series and the Systematic History Fund Series, state publications such as the New Jersey Archives, the Colonial and State records of North Carolina and the Calendar of Virginia State Papers; such periodicals as the *Mayflower Descendent*, the *Genealogical Advertiser*, the *Magazine of New England History*, and the three series of Putnam's *Historical Magazine*, and many rare or important town or family histories. A few items included as additions on page 19 of the catalogue of 1900 have been incorporated with the present list, so that the whole of the library's collection should be included in the two alphabets.

This list is divided into three sections as follows:—

I. State, county, and town histories and records, periodicals and other general works, arranged alphabetically under the name of the author, or if anonymous, under the title. This part of the list is intended for use with Durrie's Index.

II. Index to localities in the preceding list, including a few references to titles of anonymous books.

III. Family histories entered alphabetically under the name of the family, with numerous cross-references, mostly to families not included in Durrie's Index.

Since the publication of the catalogue of 1900, the books in this department of the library have been removed to the tower room on the balcony floor of the building. This room makes a light pleasant study. It is fitted with open shelves holding about 2,000 volumes, with special catalogues, and with other conveniences for students. A few of the longer series that have been crowded out are shelved in the cases on the balcony just outside the door. Of the state, county and town histories only those for the thirteen original states have been removed to the tower room. These include the class numbers from 974 to 975.8. A few books relating to other portions of the United States that may be required can be obtained by request at the desk.

The total number of volumes now shelved in this department for the use of genealogical students is about 2500. There are still a few copies of the catalogue of 1900 available for distribution to those interested in genealogical research who have not already received a copy.
