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## PREFATORY NOTE

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The Washington Papers, purchased by the Government in 1834 and 1849, have been repaired, mounted, and bound in 302 royal folio volumes. This is the main part of the collection. In addition to these there are 36 volumes of original diaries, 32 volumes of record letter books, 58 volumes of accounts and miscellany, and 44 volumes of what is known as the Varick Transcript (nearly all of these are still in the original bindings), making a total of 472 volumes in the entire collection.

The list here printed covers the first 15 volumes and a part of the sixteenth volume of the 302-volume set, beginning with the earliest papers and ending with Washington's copy of the Pennsylvania Packet which gives an account of the American losses at the battle of Bunker Hill, June 17, 1775. The next paper in the collection is Washington's commission as commander in chief, dated June 19, 1775, at which point the Revolutionary War papers of the collection properly begin.

The list catalogues every individual paper and volume in the collection up to June 19, 1775. The volumes of record letter books are noted in their chronological order; but the contents of these volumes are not entered in the list, as each volume, with the exception of "Invoices and Letters, 1755-1765, December 6-September 22," contains its own index.

The analytical index printed herewith furnishes a subjective grouping of the Washington Papers during the Colonial period, which makes them now for the first time easy of exact consultation.

Calendars of the papers covering the Revolutionary War period, June 19, 1775, to December 23, 1783, have been published by the Library. These are: *Correspondence with the Continental Congress, Washington, Government Printing Office, 1906, 1 volume*, and *Correspondence with the Military Officers of every rank and service, Washington, Government Printing Office, 1915, 4 volumes*. In these calendars, however, the correspondence with the civil authorities (known as Series C) and the personal letters were omitted.
